<b>Test-1</b>	For candidates applying for Diploma Courses in Applied Art, Architectural Assistantship, Art for Drawing Teachers, Automobile Engineering, Cosmetology & Health, Chemical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Civil Engineering (Construction Technology), Civil Engg. (Public Health & Environment Engineering), Computer Engineering Electrical Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering, Digital Electronics, Medical Electronics, Fashion Designing, Garment Fabrication Technology, Information Technology Enabled Services & Management (ITES&M), Interior Design, Instrumentation & Control, Library & Information Science, Mechanical Engineering, Mechanical Engg. (Maintenance Engg.) Medical Laboratory Technology, Polymer Technology, Printing Technology, Production Engineering, Textile Design, Tool & Die Making.	<p><b>The candidate should have passed 10<sup>th</sup> class or any other examination</b> recognized as equivalent to 10th class examination, conducted by CBSE / other board <b>with minimum 35%</b> or 3.7 CGPA aggregate. The subjects <b>Science, Mathematics and English are compulsory and the candidate should have passed in each of these three subjects.</b></p> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Candidates passing /qualifying class 10th under the grading system should have obtained minimum pass grade in the compulsory subjects i.e., Science, Mathematics and English.</li> <li>Any other criteria as prescribed by CBSE in new pattern.</li> </ol>
<b>Test-2</b>	For candidates applying for Modern Office Practice (English), Modern Office Practice (Hindi)	<b>The candidate should have passed Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (Class XII)</b> of the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Delhi <b>in any stream of 10+2</b> or any other examination recognized as equivalent to the Senior Secondary School Certificate with minimum 35% marks in aggregate of the best three subjects including English for MOP (Eng.) and Hindi or Sanskrit for MOP (Hindi). The candidate should have obtained pass marks in the relevant subject i.e. English for MOP (English) and Hindi/Sanskrit for MOP (Hindi).
<b>Test-3</b>	For candidates applying for Pharmacy	Passed 10+2 examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the Mathematics /  Biology (Botany and Zoology).
<b>Test-4</b>	For candidates applying for Lateral Entry	Passed 10+2 Std examination with Physics

	(For Delhi region candidates only).	<p>and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the Mathematics / Biology ( Botany and Zoology) OR  10+2 Science (with Mathematics as one of the Subject) or 10+2 Science with Technical Vocational</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>10 + <b>2 years ITI</b> with appropriate Trade in that order shall be eligible for admission to Second Year Diploma Course(s) of appropriate Programme. The ITIs/ ITCs must be from Institutes located <b>only</b> in Delhi and affiliated to DGE&amp;T/BTE, Delhi. ITI student who had already appeared for his/her final exam has to submit pass certificate/mark sheet on or before 30/11/2020 otherwise his/her provisional admission stands cancelled.</p> <p>10 + ITI (2 years) with appropriate Trade against 10% supernumerary seats in analogous disciplines of Architectural Assistantship, Automobile Engineering, Civil Engineering, Civil Engineering (Construction Technology), Computer Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electronics &amp; Communication Engineering, Digital Electronics, Medical Electronics, Mechanical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering (Maintenance Engineering), Polymer Technology, Production Engineering, Civil Engineering (Public Health &amp; Environment Engineering), Information Technology Enabled Services &amp; Management (ITES &amp; M), Textile Design, Tool &amp; Die Making.</p>
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\* For admission in various diploma courses, the candidate should have qualifications as per minimum eligibility criteria (with or without grace marks).

**NOTE:** (a) *If a candidate has passed his / her qualifying exam from board other than CBSE or State board (India), it will be sole responsibility of the candidate to produce equivalence certificate (CBSE) of qualifying exam (10<sup>th</sup> / 12<sup>th</sup> as applicable) at the time of counseling, failing which, the candidature will not be considered.*
